While the Clinical Investigator is primarily responsible for the overall conduct, and management of the clinical trial at the investigator site, the CRC supports, facilitates and coordinates the daily clinical trial activities and plays a critical role in the conduct of the study.

They typically work under the direction of the principal investigator (PI), who is in charge of designing, conducting, and managing the clinical trial from a high level.
