Blossom-end rot is not a disease but instead is a nutrient deficiency. The nutrient that is lacking is calcium. Blossom-end rot will be a rot that is dark brown in color and has a tough, leathery feel. The rot will be on the blossom-end of the tomato fruit. The spot is usually about the size of a dime and enlarges to the size of a half-dollar.
