The number of total training hours for each academy differs by each respective academy, but all academies consist of 400 minimum hours for basic and 249 hrs. for basic corrections. Contact information for each POST accredited academy is found here. Only Louisiana law enforcement agencies may sponsor/nominate students for a POST accredited academy.

Louisiana Law Enforcement Officers I. Minimum Training Requirements All level 1(basic) and level 2 (basic Corrections) certified peace officers, excluding elected and appointed agency-heads, are required to complete the following in-service requirements annually, between January 1st and December 31 st , beginning the first calendar year after receiving their POST certification:

LCLE: POST Inservice Training

Any peace officer hired prior to January 1, 1986, who interrupts his full time continuous law enforcement employment for a period in excess of five (5) years ("break in service")can reinstate their grandfathership by successfully completing the "legal aspects" and "firearms" sections of the Louisiana Law Enforcement Basic Training Manual, and completing the necessary requirements for POST ...

LCLE: Peace Officer Standards and Training Council

The Louisiana State Police Training Academy provides basic training for State Police cadets and continuing training for troopers through quarterly firearms training and annual in-service training. The Academy also provides continuing education training for other law enforcement agencies as well as DPS non-commissioned personnel.

Louisiana State Police - Training Academy

There are 27 basic training academies for peace officers in the state of Louisiana that are approved by the POST Council. The only way to attend one of these academies is to first be hired by a police department or sheriff's office in the state. The Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Office operates the Acadiana Law Enforcement Training Academy (ALETA). ALETA trains law enforcement candidates from throughout Louisiana to become P.O.S.T. certified law enforcement officers. Academies are 15 weeks long and include physical training & conditioning along with classroom instruction.

All full-time sworn law enforcement officers in Louisiana must successfully complete a Louisiana Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) approved basic law enforcement academy. The St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office Basic Training Academy consists of 14 weeks (526 hours) of basic law enforcement training.
