U.S. Government Publishing Office Style Manual

Transparent objects and layers should be flattened in the native file before publishing. Submitted files should not contain crop marks, trim marks, bookmarks, comments, invisible objects, annotations, placeholder text, or metadata. All images (both cover and manuscript) should be at least 300 DPI. PDFs should be optimized.
