Clinical expression of vertebrobasilar dolichoectasia (VBD) is variable and includes compression of cranial nerves or brain stem, 1-5 obstructive hydrocephalus, 3,6 and ischemia in vertebrobasilar arterial territory. 7-13 However, pathological changes in the arterial wall, consisting primarily in defects in the internal elastic lamina with thinning of the media secondary to smooth muscle atrophy, 14-16 may predispose patients to intracranial bleeding of various kinds.

Vertebrobasilar dolichoectasia (VBD) is a chronic disorder with various cerebrovascular and compressive manifestations, involving subarachnoid hemorrhage (SAH). Occurrence of SAH shortly after worsening of clinical VBD symptoms has occasionally been reported.

Vertebrobasilar dolichoectasia (VBD) is characterized by dilatation, elongation, and tortuosity of the vertebrobasilar arteries, with the presenting symptoms resulting from ischemia or compression of the brainstem. Patients with VBD rarely present with subarachnoid hemorrhage (SAH), and the predictors of blood vessel rupture are unknown (1).
